Publication of Accommodation Prices

All rooms in the facility are single rooms with private en-suite. Each room has a maximum occupancy of 1.

Price (the maximum accommodation price that a resident could be charged for a room)

<u>Maximum</u> Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD):	\$550,000.00
<u>Maximum</u> Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP):	\$126.27

Payment Options: Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit, a daily payment, or a combination of both.

A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments.

Paradise Lakes Care Centre offers light filled single rooms with individual en-suites. Our residents live in an atmosphere that is as close as possible to a “home felt” environment and with close contact to the community around them. Emergency call buttons are located in the bedroom and bathroom of each room. Several of the bedrooms have views of the lake whilst others open onto verandas where residents can sit and enjoy views of the landscaped gardens.
